Market Goat Project

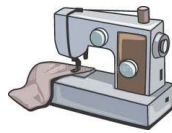
The Market Goat Project will allow you to learn about meat animals, judge animals, and even show them in local and area 4-H Meat Goat

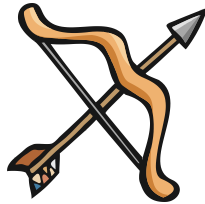
